BUFFALO, N.Y. - Donald W. Rowe, PhD, director of the Office of Public Health Practice and a faculty member in the Department of Community Health and Health Behavior at the University at Buffalo School of Public Health and Health Professions, has been named the 2015 recipient of the Herman M. Biggs Public Health Award by the New York State Public Health Association.

The award, which is given annually to an individual who is recognized for outstanding achievement in public health, is named for Herman M. Biggs, MD, a pioneer in the field of public health and New York State public health commissioner for 26 years.

In a career spanning 40 years, Rowe is recognized for his longstanding contributions to tobacco control, emergency preparedness, community service, coalition building and rural health. As the director of the Office of Public Health Practice, he focuses on connecting the school with the practice community so that together they have an opportunity to improve the health of communities.

In addition, Rowe teaches courses in public health practice and community health assessment and surveillance.
